# Boat Certificate for Canoes

- All boats and associated equipment are required to be examined before use.
- A self assessment should be carried out annually including a 'swamp' test to prove internal boat buoyancy.
- An Area/County inspection should be carried out at least once in three years.
- In each case two copies of the certificate of examination should be sent to the Area/County Boat Registrar for recording before equipment is used.
- All boats should display a valid (i.e. in date) boat sticker.
- The details of any boat transferred to another Scout Group must be notified to the Area/Couty Boat Registrar
- All Scout references must be removed before disposing of a boat and the Area/County Boat Registrar notified accordingly.

**Associated equipment should be checked by the examiner with further examination as recommended by the manufacturer.**
